Admission Test Guidelines Fall 2025 INSTRUCTIONS

Reporting Time: 9:00 am

Venue: SB 001 Auditorium (SB Building)

- The admission test consists of three rounds designed to assess the skills and suitability of candidates for the BBA (Hons.) and BS Business Intelligence and Analytics programs.
- The three rounds include:

Round 1: Simulation (Lab-Based Activity)

Round 2: Case Study (Classroom Activity)

Round 3: Interview Session (details are give below)

- Please refer to the sample test to gain insight into the types of questions that will be presented during the admission test.
- Candidates are required to participate in all three rounds of the admission test.
- Each round has a designated time limit: 1.5 hours for Round 1, 1 hour for Round 2, and 15 to 20 minutes for the interview.
- Stationery will be provided by the School of Management Sciences.
- Mobile phones are strictly prohibited in the admission test premises.
- Any use of unfair means during the test will result in immediate disqualification from the admission process. The candidate will not be allowed to apply to any program at BNU.

Round 1: Simulation (Weightage: 15%)

Duration: 1 hour and 30 minutes

Format: Lab-Based Activity

Task:

 Candidates will run a business simulation on lab computers. The simulation will require candidates to make strategic decisions as they run a virtual business. 10:00 am to 11:30 am

- A briefing on the simulation interface will be provided before the activity.
- After completing the simulation, candidates will write a short reflective essay explaining their key decisions and reasoning.

Assessment Criteria: simulation results, strategic decision-making, analytical thinking, and time management.

Round 2: Classroom Activity (Weightage: 15%)

• Duration: 1 hour

11:30 am to 12:30 pm

- *Format:* Classroom activity involving individual analysis of reallife scenarios/case studies.
- Task: Candidates will be given a real-life scenario or case study to read and analyse. Candidates will then write their insights and reflections individually (scenario/case study will be provided on the spot).
- Assessment Criteria: writing clarity, analytical thinking, and critical reasoning.

SOCIAL BREAK

Time: 12:30 pm - 1:00 pm

A 30-minute refreshment break where candidates and their parents can meet and interact with current BBA (Hons.) and BS Business Intelligence and Analytics students and faculty.

Round 3: Interview (Weightage: 20%)

- *Time:* Starts at 1:00 pm onwards (approximately 10 minutes per candidate)
- Format: One-on-one interview with faculty members.
