Thesis Evaluation Process

Internal Research Committee

- Approval of ideas, methods.
- Supervisor allocation

Steps before topics are approved in BOS and BOF:

- Allotment of supervisors
- Brainstorming sessions to develop and mature the idea

After the approval steps involved:

- Supervisees do regular meetings with the supervisors
- **Time allotted for submission:**
 - Students are given two semesters to complete their thesis/project

How are they evaluated?

- Students are evaluated by the internal supervisors and external examiners

Public Display of Thesis and Projects

- Public display of projects and thesis

Marks allotted to external jury members and internal examiner:

For Thesis

- Internal: 70%
- External Examiner: 30%

For Projects

- Display: 25%
- Write Up: 50%
- Viva: 25%
- Signed and verified by supervisor, external examiner and dean

Who enters the marks? Internal supervisor enters the marks in the CMS, written report signed by external examiner and shared with Examination Department.
